As we make our way out of a season of intense isolation, it is important to remember we are not alone as individuals or congregations. Each and every one of us has been called to share in the minisgtry of Christ Jesus our Lord. Each and every one of us is a member of the one body of Christ.

We each have a role in the ministry of the whole synod as individuals and congregations. Each congregation's minisgtry can be fortified and strengthened by by the minisgtry and presence of the congregations around it.





