Dear ones, I can't tell you how good it felt to start this new year.

There is an energy in the air that I haven't felt since before the pandemic. That's not quite it either... it's not like going back to a "before"; it's more like moving into something new.

Students are engaging. They're showing up. There's joy. It's so good.

We handed out cotton candy at Winona State again this year during Welcome Weekend. And, it's true, students were engaging. They didn't just walk by, and they didn't just get their cotton candy and move on. They stopped, looked at stickers and info, talked with me about their week- what it was like moving in, where they were from, if they felt nervous about finding classes. (A couple of small groups of students were going around campus to find their classes to be ready for Monday!

Voluntarily!)

Susan, one of our board members- who is also a nursing professor- was in her office in a building near where we were handing out the sticky sweet treat. She could hear students laughing and talking excitedly outside her window. I sent her a text with a picture of us at the gazebo and thanked her for helping us reserve the spot. She decided to come outside.

Susan noticed we were running low on our welcome bags, so she offered to go to the LCC to pick up the rest. We ran out within an hour of being on campus! She shared how heartwarming it was to hear the students' joy and made plans to welcome even more next year. (Susan is a queen when it comes to hospitality.)


As I drove to the LCC the next night for our first dinner and worship of the year, I hoped people would show up. One first year student was celebrating her birthday and came to dinner with a friend. Another arrived, thankful for the text I'd sent to her the day before. (She seemed homesick at the club fair, so I checked in with her later.) A few others had been at the club fair, and some remembered us from cotton candy. Then, just before worship, eight new people walked in! We had to print more bulletins! When I asked if anyone would like to help with the wine and juice during communion, a first year student raised her hand. After worship, students stuck around to visit, laughing and eating the rest of the communion bread and treats from dinner.

In terms of numbers, I hadn't seen that many students since early 2020. (Including my 7-month-old, we had 26 people that first night.) In terms of the spirit of it all-beyond the numbers- it felt like "old times", but not quite. It felt new. Like joy and resilience and possibility.

It feels like hope.

As St. Paul wrote in his letter to the Romans: May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.


